Committee reports and recommendations are made to the School Board as requested by the Board, such advice is to be incorporated annually into the Superintendent's recommendations for changes to the Student Handbooks. ~~At a minimum, the committees submit a written report of their findings and recommendations by April 15<sup>th</sup> each year to the School Board.~~ The Board considers the committees' recommendations when establishing and reviewing student discipline policy.

The Student Discipline Committee is made up of PTO/PTA Presidents. They will assist the Superintendent in the development of student discipline policies and procedures. ~~is comprised of parents and teachers, and may also include persons whose expertise or experience is needed.~~ This committee reviews such issues as student discipline, disruptive classroom behavior, and the dissemination of student conduct information.

Behavioral Intervention Committee

Another ~~parent-teacher~~ advisory committee ~~serves is as~~ the District's Behavioral Intervention Committee ~~to~~ which develops, implements, and monitors procedures for using behavioral interventions in accordance with Board Policy 7.230, Discipline for Students with Disabilities.
