The Board of Education of the Bloomington Public Schools, School District 87, McLean County, Illinois, met in Special Session.

Present from the administrative staff were Dr. Barry Reilly, Dr. Herschel Hannah and Mr. David Wood.

It was moved by Mr. Dirks, seconded by Ms. Webster that Dr. Hannah be appointed Secretary pro Tem. Upon a roll call vote, all Members present voted "Aye." Motion carried.

It was moved by Mr. Harrison, seconded by Dr. Perry, that the Board go into Closed Session for the purpose of considering a student disciplinary case. Upon a roll call vote, all Members present voted "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Mr. Dirks, seconded by Dr. Perry, that the Board expel Student 11-1 for the remainder of the 2010-11 school year as well as the entire 2011-12 school year and that the student be provided the opportunity to attend the alternative SAVE school program for the duration of the expulsion. Upon a roll call vote, all Members present voted "Aye." Motion carried.
