Entrance Criteria

- **Academically Consistent.**
 - Demonstrates a **high “B” average** or above.
 - Only the top students will be chosen due to limited placement at clinical sites.
- **Has own car or method of transportation.**
 - See BACC Transportation Agreement.
 - **CANNOT** rely on another HO II student to drive.
- Demonstrates a **maturity** level that is consistent with the ability to **perform in a professional mode.**
 - Good attitude, good anger control etc.
 - *This is up to the discretion of the instructor.*
- Verbalizes a sincere motivation/desire for **advancement** in the **Healthcare field.**
- **Attendance must be in good standing:** No more than **10 absences (excused or unexcused)** per year.
 - Does not include absences due to non-BHS schools not being in session.
 - Exceptions may be granted per instructor approval. *ie: family emergencies.*
- Must demonstrate **self-motivation and responsibility**, which includes but is not limited to:
 - punctuality
 - assignments handed in on time
 - seeks new learning opportunities
 - demonstrates an INTEREST in subject matter
 - utilizes class and clinical site time wisely
- This includes, but not limited to:
 - staying awake in class
 - utilizing class time appropriately-
 - (i.e.: working on assignments and studying when given the in-class opportunity; demonstrating an interest in lectures, health care activities, etc.)
