1. On the first screen, type the class access code  
**24B64CB22E418C377C99**  
in the access code field.

2. Follow the instructions to register. Please DO NOT use your full name as your user name. Write your user name on the blank line above exactly as you typed it.

3. At the end of registration process, the SuccessNet login page appears.

Log in by typing your user name and password.
