# 2010 Summer School Programs

---

- **Elementary Summer School**
  - Five week program serving students completing grades K – 5
- **Extended School Year (ESY)**
  - Five week program serving students whose IEPs indicate a need for special education services to extend the school year
- **Early Start**
  - Three week program serving students at an individual school prior to the start of the school year
- **Transition Program**
  - Short program designed to help students entering middle and high school prior to the start of the school year



# Elementary Summer School & Extended School Year

---

- Time Frame
  - Elementary Summer School and the Extended School Year Program will run for 5 weeks beginning 1 week after the last day of school
  - Dates: Monday – Thursday  
June 7 – July 8, 2010
  - Tuition: \$50 per student (summer school)



# Elementary Summer School & Extended School Year

---

- Program Components
  - 70 hours of instruction focusing on literacy and mathematics
  - Pre and Post assessment of skills
  - Research Based Curriculum
- Instructional Supports
  - Professional Development & Collaborative Planning for Teachers
- Student Support
  - Breakfast
  - Daily Transportation



# Bloomington Junior High School

## Summer School

---

- Available for students who do not meet promotion requirements in one or two core subjects
  - Reading/Language Arts
  - Math
  - Science
  - Social Studies
  - Physical Education
- Time Frame: Monday – Thursday, June 7 – July 8
- Tuition: \$150 per course



# Early Start & Transition Programs

---

- Early Start Programs
    - Sheridan Elementary School
    - Irving Elementary School
  - 5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Transition Program
  - Raider 101 Transition Program
- \*Tuition free to recommended students



# Funding Sources

- All tuition free and reduced tuition programs are grant funded for FY10
- Elementary Summer School & Extended School Year
  - Title I
  - IDEA reimbursement
  - Tuition
- Early Start & Transition Programs
  - AGTF Gift (State Farm)
- BJHS Summer School
  - Tuition
