Logging in

Tutor.com is only free to those who possess a library card issued at **Bloomington Public Library**. It is a paid service to others.

Because of this, those using the library's account to access these services **must** log on to Tutor.com via the library's website – www.BloomingtonLibrary.org.

From the library's homepage, look for "Online Resources" in the "Find" section. After clicking, look to the right and click on "Online Resources in Alphabetical Order;" then scroll to Tutor.com.

Enter your library card number when prompted.

Tutor.com

provides **FREE**, one-on-one tutoring in an interactive classroom with access to whiteboards, drawing tools, instant messaging and file sharing. At session's end, the student can print the whiteboards, print a transcript of the session and/or have the conversation emailed to them.

The service is available daily from 3 to 11 p.m. from either a home computer or one of the library's computers. Using the service from a home computer will require input of your Bloomington Public Library card number.
