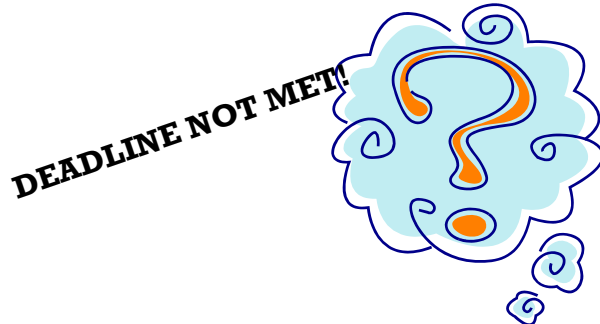

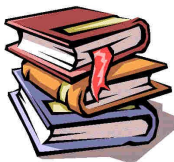

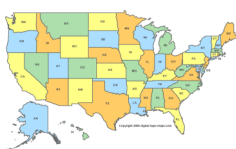


## An Interview With Chloe By Morgan

## Snack-tastic Holiday Mix

In medium saucepan, combine butter, Splenda, corn syrup & cinnamon. Stir over low heat. Once mixture is blended and bubbling, stir in both cereals and coat with mixture. Stir for 2 1/2 min or until cereal is well coated. Mix in fruit pieces and almonds and remove from heat. Spread mixture out onto foil to cool. Eat when cool. YUM!!

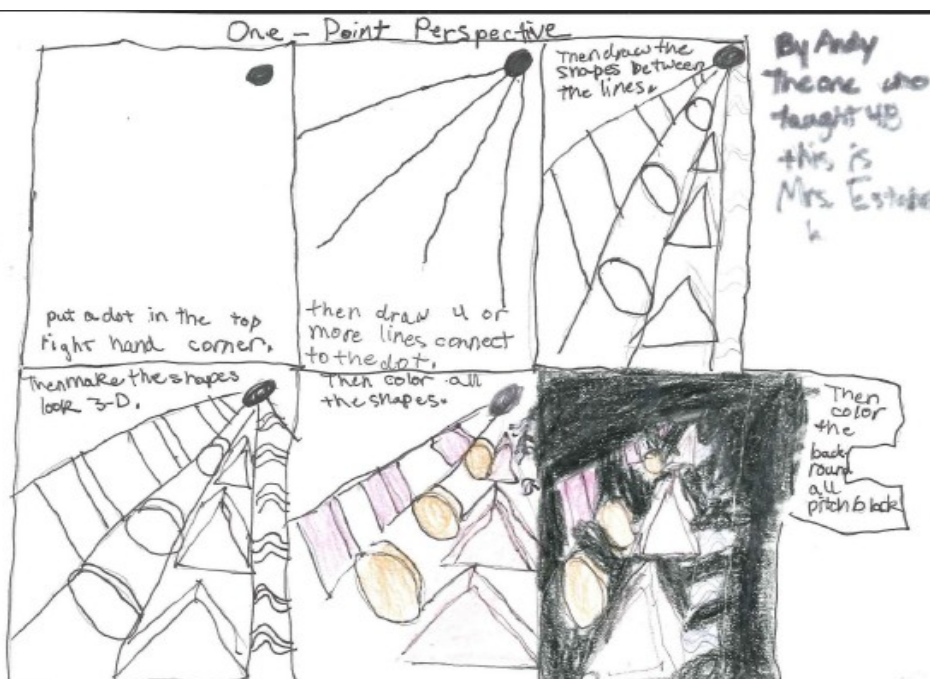
