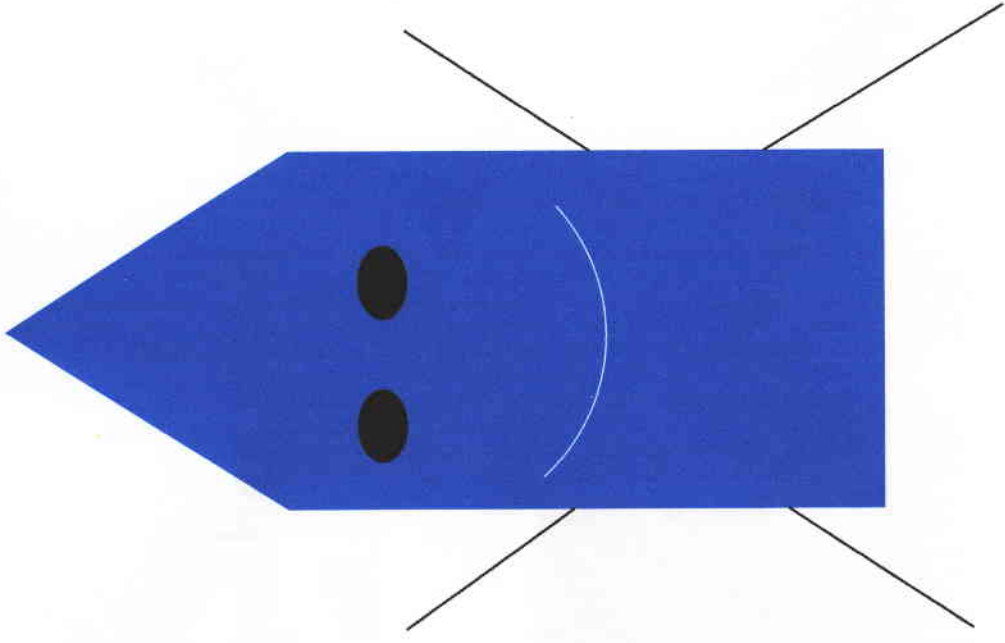
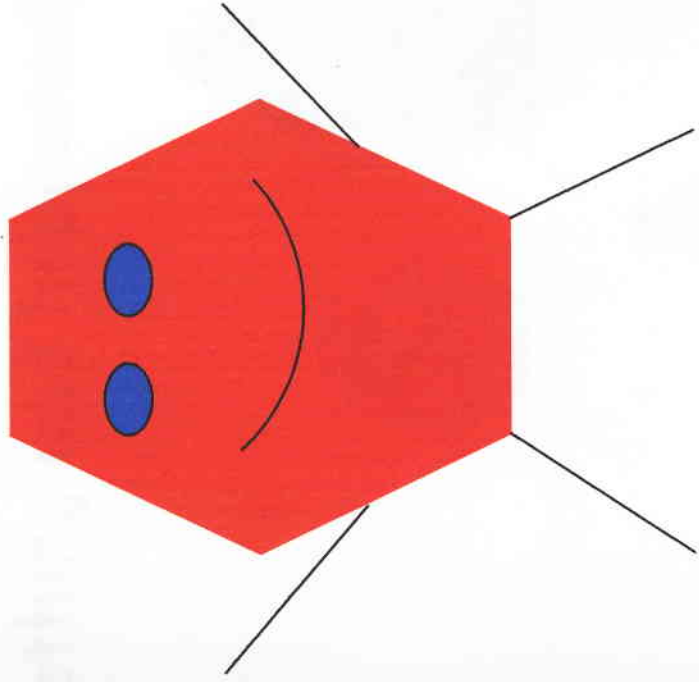
P O L Y G O N S



One day two shapes met together and got married. Their names were Rod the Quadrilateral and Tina the Triangle.

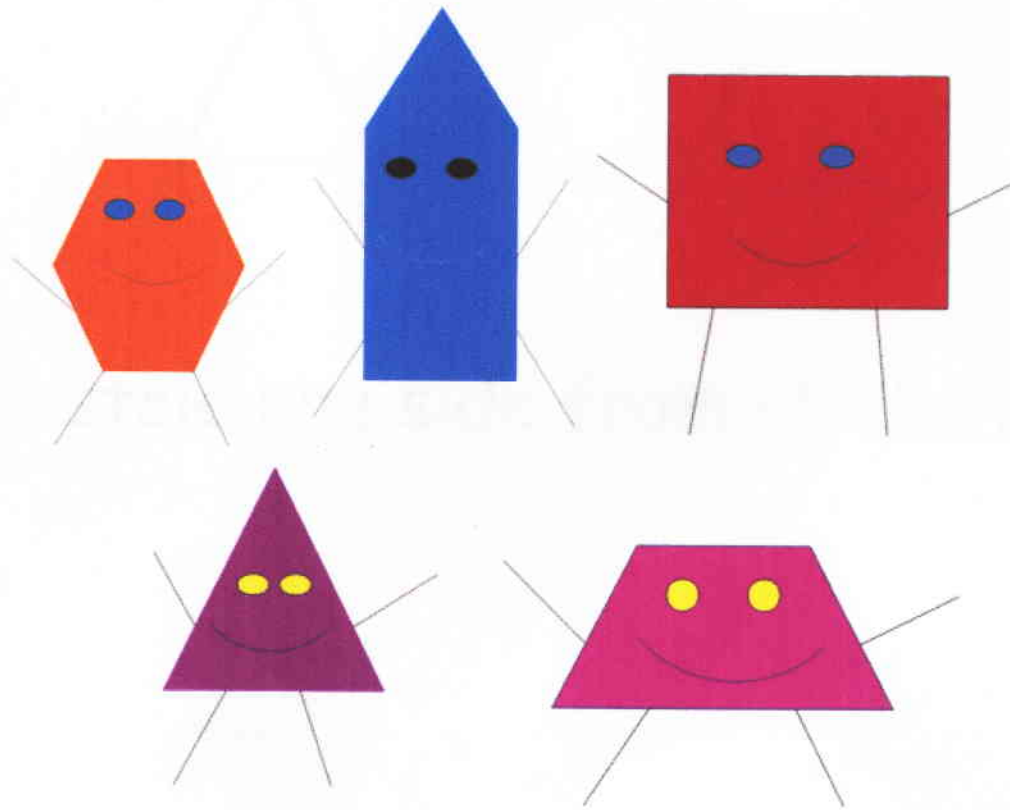


After a couple years the triangle and square had three kids. The first was Tara the Trapezoid. She was a good shape.

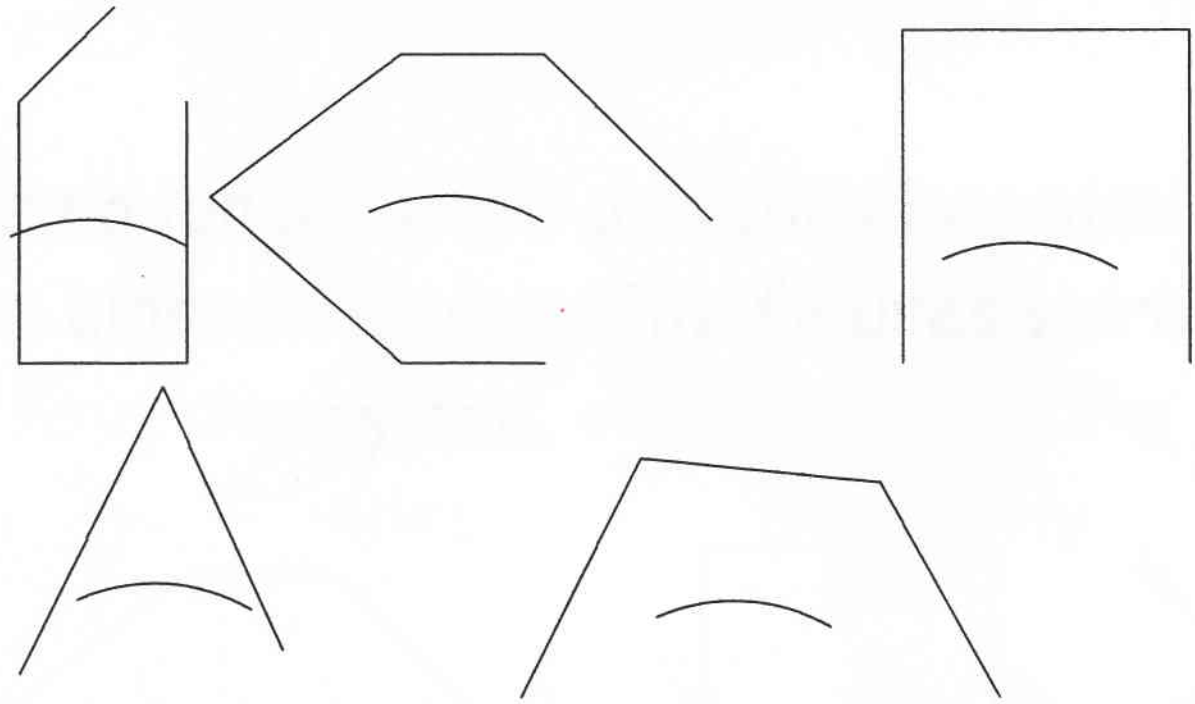


The last two kids were a little odd. Their names were Hector the Hexagon and Payton the Pentagon.

The shapes were living happily together until something bad happened to them all.

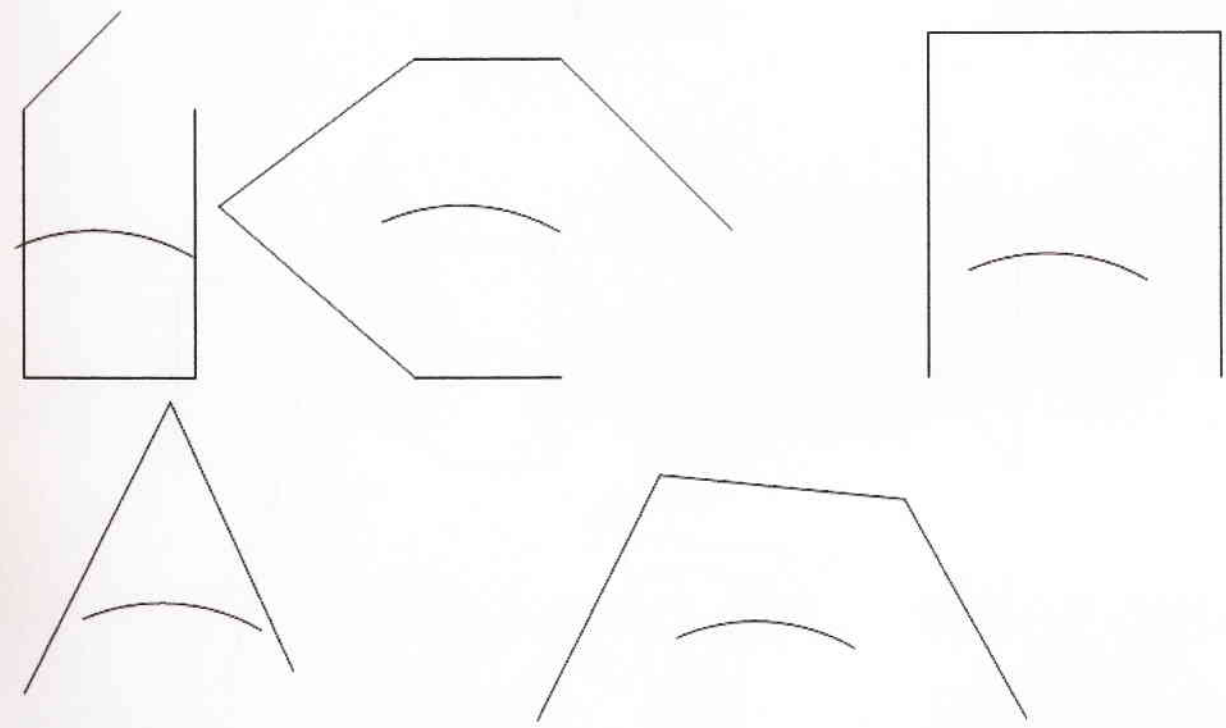

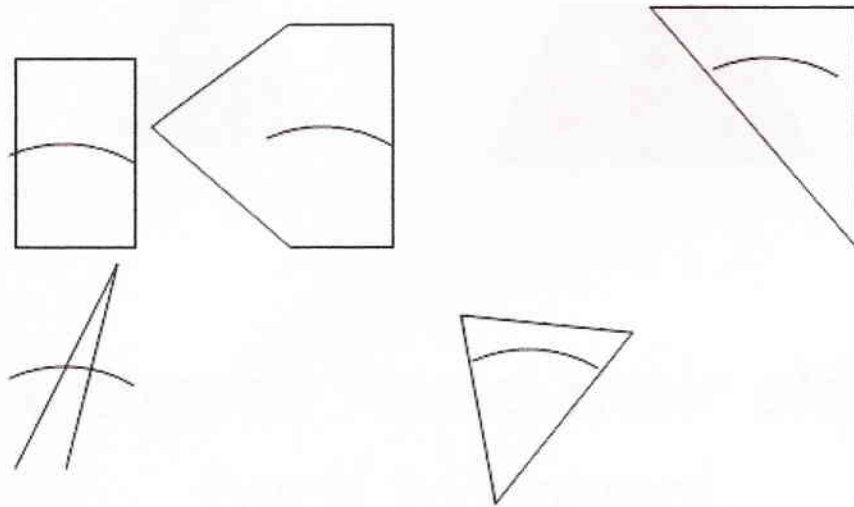


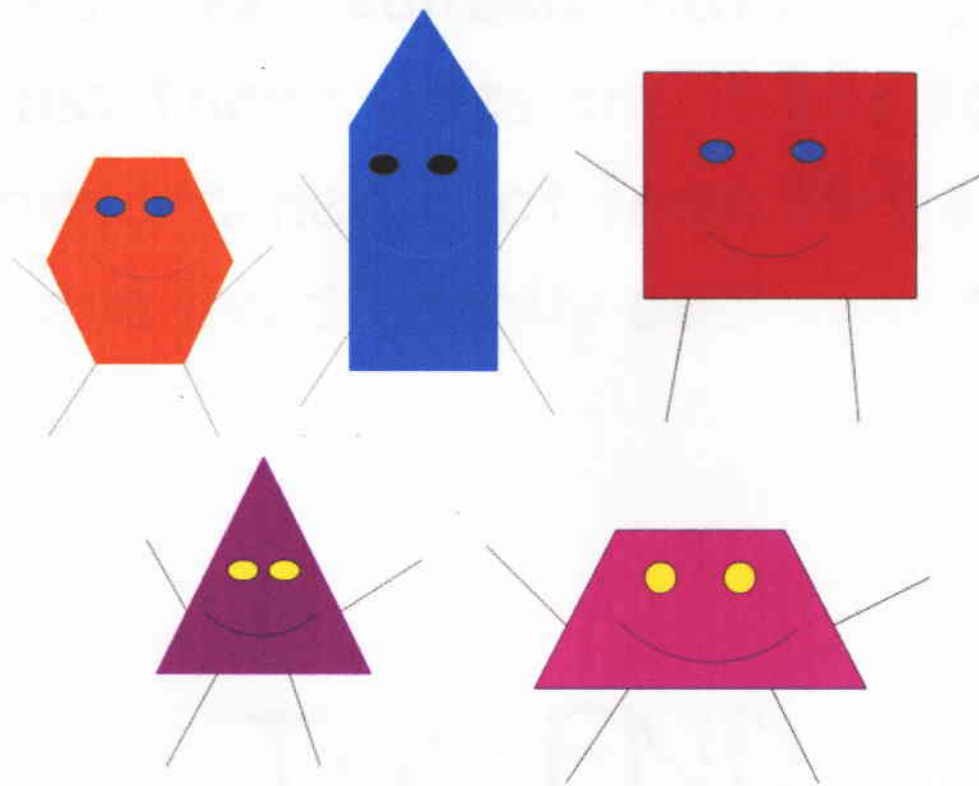
A thief stole one side from all the shapes.
