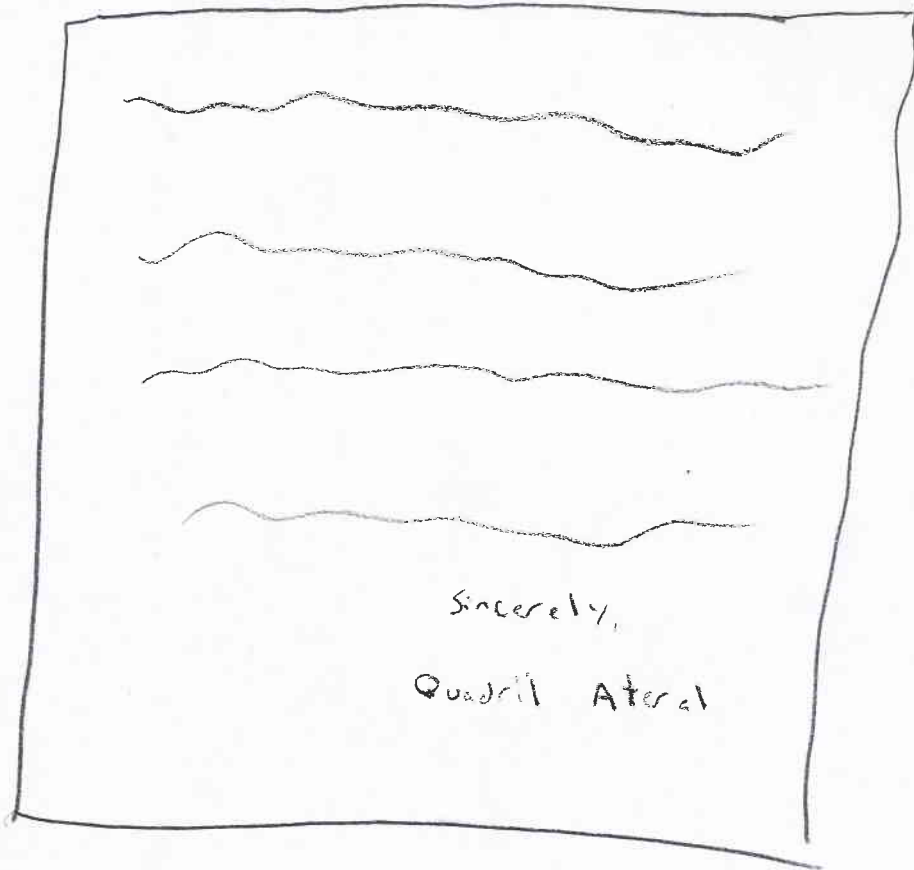

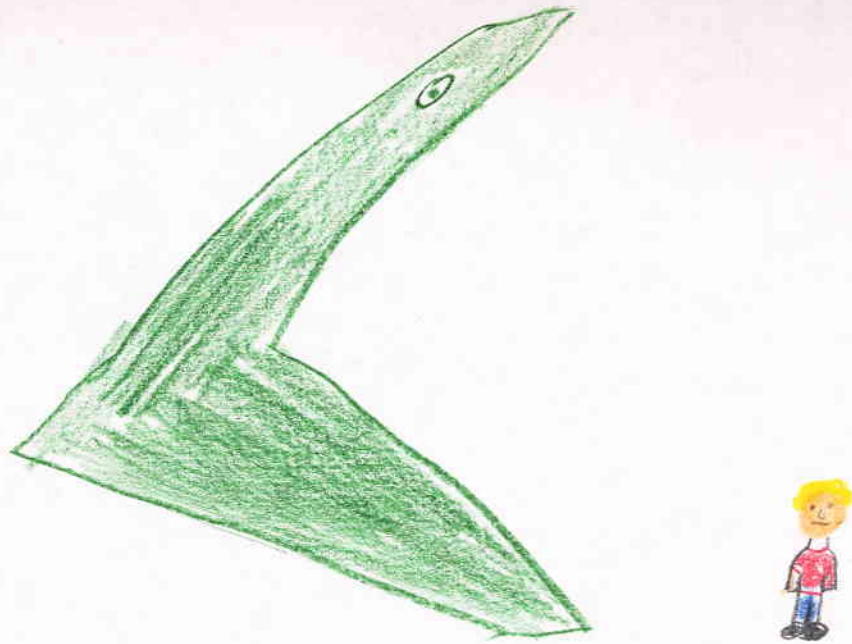

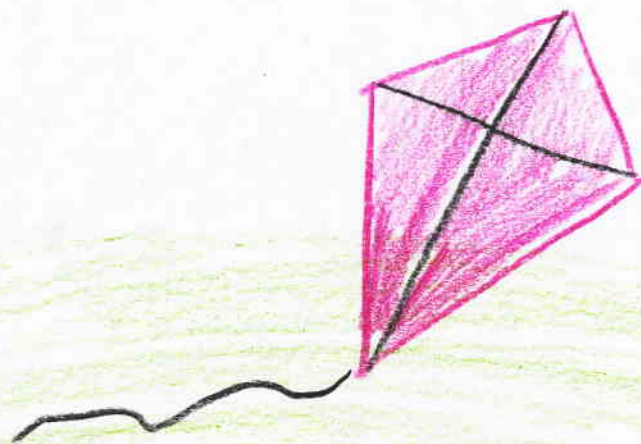

Johnny was so confused when he read the note but he figured he should get started quickly on the task to get his beloved Poly back. So he started off to the Talking Cave.



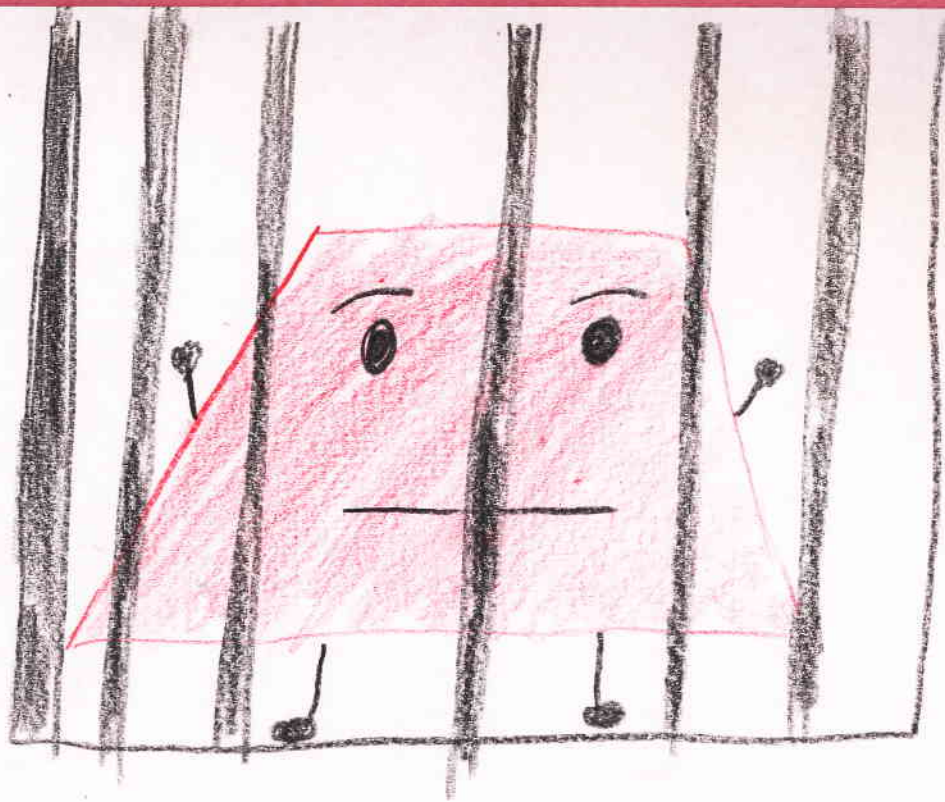
Once Johnny arrived upon the cave, he had to figure out a way to

Johnny took off.



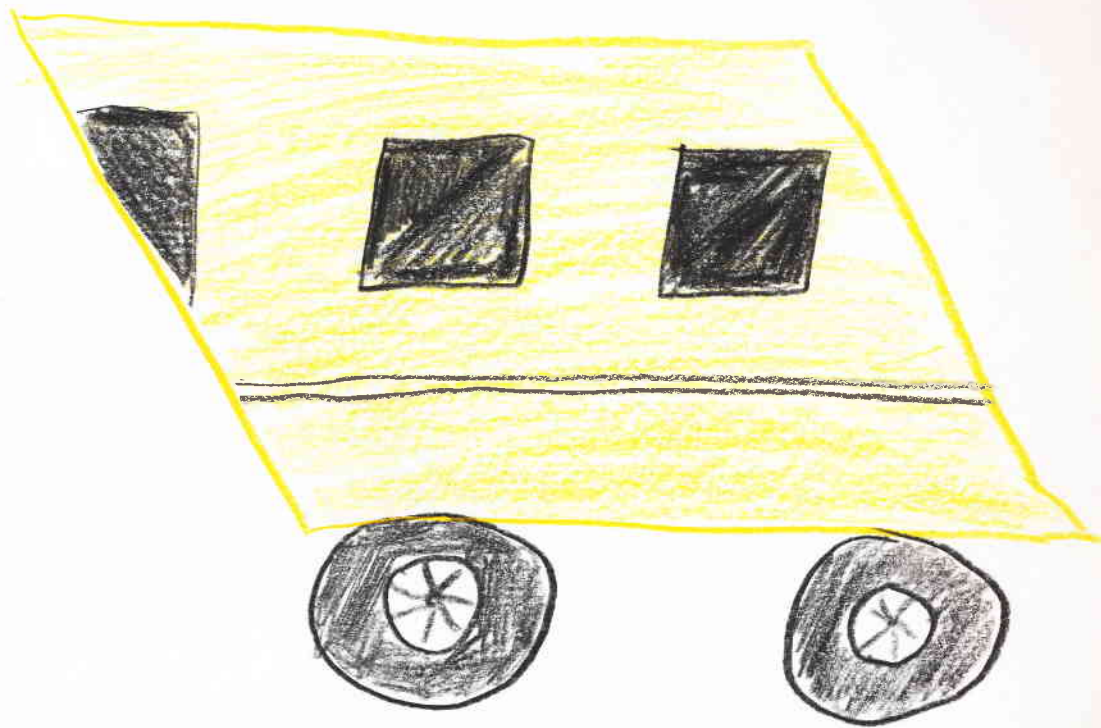
As Johnny arrived at the corner of Dell and Buffet, he saw a kite lying in the park. He picked it up and unraveled the string and flew



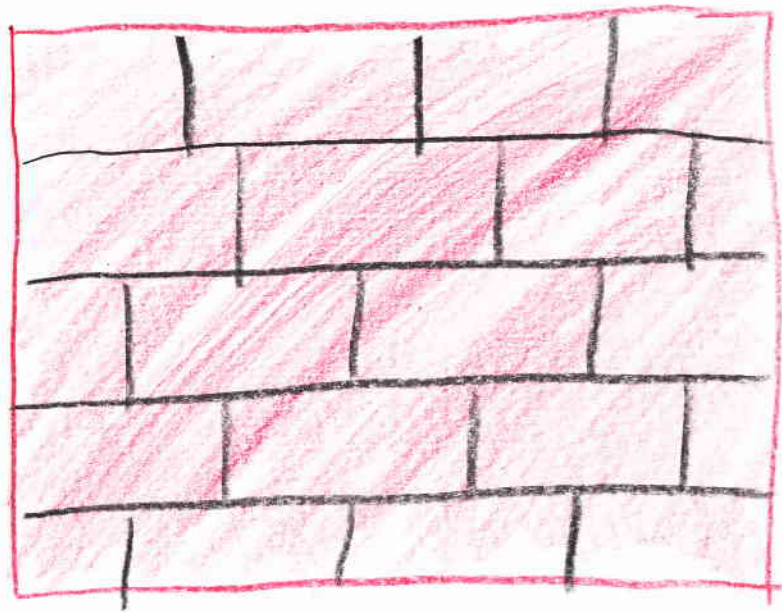
the kite in the air. As the sun hit the kite, Johnny realized that the shadow of the kite was a map to Zoid.



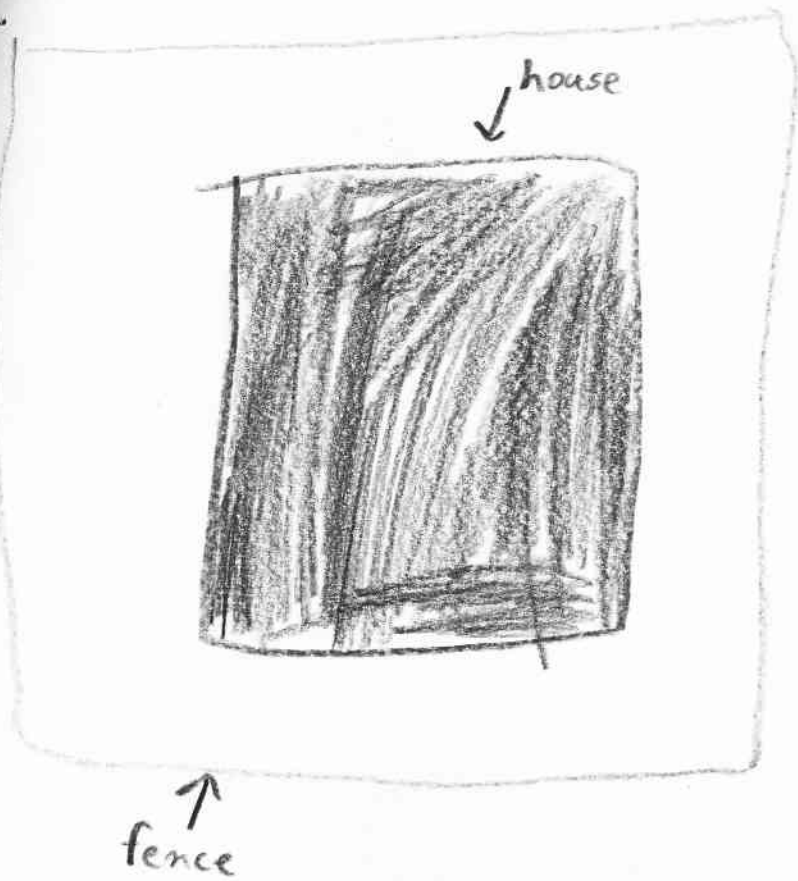
