

# OWLET School

Your students have been participating in OWLET School. We are taking these first 2 weeks of school to clearly define and practice the expectations of the classroom and school. Every morning we say the pledge "Oakland Owls are respectful. We are responsible. We are safe. We give a hoot!" We have also been learning about our classroom card system, which clearly defines consequences for not following teacher directions and school rules. Your child will graduate from OWL School on August 31. Starting September 1, every student will be expected to know and follow the rules at school while being a role model for others. We are wise Oakland owls!

## Our Classroom Card System

All students will start the day with a solid green card. If classroom or school rules are not followed, students will turn their card in the following order:

- **Yellow**-verbal reminder
- **Red**-visual reminder
- **Blue**-visit the thinking spot and complete self-reflection
- **Pink**-visit the office

If your child has a green card at the end of the day, he/she is eligible for Child of the Day the next day, which means being the special helper, line leader, and sitting in the enormous bean bag chair on the rug. Your child also earns paper bucket certificates for good behavior, which means he/she gets to put a marble in the jar and their certificate (a small paper bucket) goes into the class bucket (a real one), which then goes into the big school bucket for possible prizes at the end of the week.
