

MINUTES - REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

February 26, 2020

The Board of Education of the Bloomington Public Schools, School District 87, McLean County, Illinois, met in Regular Session.

Ms. Wilma Gleason, Board Secretary, established a quorum and the following Members were present: Mr. James Almeda, Ms. Elizabeth Fox Anvick, Mrs. Kiasha Henry, Mr. Charles Irwin, Mr. Mark Wylie, and Ms. Brigitte Beasley, Board President.

Present from the administrative staff were Dr. Barry Reilly, Dr. Herschel Hannah, and Dr. Colin Manahan.

It was moved by Ms. Fox Anvick, seconded by Mr. Almeda, that the Board approve the February 12, 2020 Regular Board Meeting Minutes. Upon a roll call vote, Almeda, Fox Anvick, Houtzel, Irwin, Wylie and Beasley voted "Aye"; Henry abstained due to absence on February 12, 2020. Motion carried.
