

MINUTES - REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

May 9, 2018 6:30 P.M. Educational Services Center

The Board of Education of the Bloomington Public Schools, School District 87, McLean County, Illinois, met in Regular Session.

The following Members were present: Mrs. Fox Anvick, Mr. Charles Irwin, Mr. Mark Wylie, Mrs. Mary Yount, and Ms. Brigette Beasley, Board Vice President.

It was moved by Mr. Irwin, seconded by Mr. Wylie, that the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Education held on April 25, 2018 be approved. Upon a roll call vote, all Members present voted "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board and Administration congratulated Anna Bauer, a BHS Junior, who is one of 250 high school students in the world selected to participate in the 2018 High School Honors Performance Series at the Sydney Opera House in Australia this summer.
