Course Title: 081830 Foods II (Semester; ½ credit)

Course Description: This course would focus on advanced food preparation techniques. This would include topics such as advanced food preparation skills, advanced baking and pastry techniques, exploration into international foods/cuisines, and a “Designing a Food Truck” project. This course is an extension of Foods I and is built on the basic skills students learn in Foods I. This course continues to allow students to develop the skills necessary to plan and prepare nutritious meals and snacks for future life. The experiences in the food lab will help students learn proper cooking techniques and meal management while working in a group setting. Beyond the basics of nutrition, students will examine a variety of topics such as sports nutrition, ethnic cooking, cake decorating, and consumer product testing.
