

2020-2021 Student Guidelines & Expectations

STUDENTS

- A. PRIORITIES** - This year our courses will prioritize these items:
- a. **Health and Safety** - The social, emotional, and physical health and safety of our students and staff are our highest priority.
 - b. **Guidelines and Recommendations** - We will use guidance from national, state, and local health agencies as we make decisions.
 - c. **Learning** - We will create the best learning environment possible for our students.
- B. EXPECTATIONS** - Our expectations for students will be as follows:
- a. **Attendance** - Students will be expected to attend class during their regular class section-time over Zoom, Monday-Friday. Individual teachers may instead use a check-in system, in which case check-ins should be done daily. For in person learners, they will be expected to attend class in person on their assigned days (A day or B day depending on their home high school.)
 - b. **Assignment Completion** - Students should work to complete assignments on the timelines set by their instructors.
 - c. **Active Participation** - Students will be expected to be active participants in their classes. Students should be active participants in video calls. They should respond to messages and emails in a timely manner.
 - d. **Honesty & Integrity** - Students will be expected to complete assignments with honesty and academic integrity. Assignments will be graded.
 - e. **School Appropriate Communication** - Students will be expected to use appropriate communication with instructors and fellow students at all times.
 - f. **Appearance and Location** - Students will be expected to engage in their video calls wearing school appropriate attire and from an appropriate location.
- C. OPPORTUNITIES** - Remote learners may have the following opportunities:
- a. **Return to School** - Remote learners may choose to return to school next semester, or as allowed by policy changes or school decisions.
 - b. **Pods** - Students may have the opportunity to do some lab work in small groups with instructors, for scheduled short periods of time.
- D. COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS** -
- a. **Masks** - Face coverings must be worn correctly (covering mouth and nose) for the entire time a student is in the BACC (classrooms, hallways, bathrooms). They should also be worn on busses. Students who refuse to wear a mask may face disciplinary action.
 - b. **Entry, Exits, and Hallways** - Students will enter the BACC through the N6 door, and exit through the N4 door. Students should follow directional signs in the hallways.
 - c. **Bathroom Use** - Bathroom use will be limited in order to ensure social distancing. Students may be asked to use a particular restroom, please respect

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that request so that you and your fellow students are not put in an unsafe situation.

- d. **Self Certification** - Parents/families will be required to self-certify temperature checks and wellness checks before attending the BACC each day per their home school policy. BACC may also take temperature checks at the door, specifically if students are starting their school day at the BACC.
- e. **Sanitary Considerations** - Students will be required to wipe down their work areas before and after class. Our custodial staff will disinfect the entire building every night. Students will be encouraged to wash their hands often.
