

FAQ's

1. When is your start date?

- a. Start date for all students is August 24.
- b. In-person start date for Monday/Tuesday students is August 24.
- c. In-person start date for Thursday/Friday students is August 27.

2. If we opt for Remote Learning at our home high school, can we still attend BACC? Can we attend in person at BACC?

- a. This is a home high school decision. You will need to connect with your home district.

3. Since my student is only In Person two days a week, do they remote learn the other days?

- a. Yes, your student will be remote learning on the days they are not in person.

4. Tri-Valley does not start until September 8. When will they start for BACC?

- a. Tri-Valley students should be starting on August 24. The Welding program at Tri-Valley High School will not start until September 8.

5. Is BACC going to remote learning?

- a. No, at this point we plan to have in person classes, with students coming to class two days per week. Please see our plan at www.district87.org/bacc.

6. My high school has gone to full-remote learning to start the year. Can I still attend BACC in person?

- a. Yes, Unit 5, District 87, and UHigh students may still attend in person.

7. My student attends Unit 5 or District 87. Will transportation still be provided to BACC?

- a. Please check with your home district for this information.

8. Do I drive or do I ride the bus?

- a. Students are expected to ride the bus if their home high school is providing a bus for transportation. The following high schools do not provide transportation and the students will be able to drive: Central Catholic, Calvary Christian, Lexington, and University High. These students should park in the NORTH lot off of Empire Street and come in door N6. Parking forms will be available on the first day of class.

9. My school is full remote learning to start the school year, can I drive?

- a. Yes, students driving need to park on the NORTH side of BACC/BHS off of Empire Street and come in Door N6.

10. Where is my room - where do I go?

- a. BACC staff will direct students to their room.

11. What do I need to bring for my class?

a. Your instructor will share this information with you.

12. How do I get to Cosmetology or Barbering class?

a. BACC will provide transportation to Hairmasters. All students must ride the bus provided by BACC. Students in FIRST SECTION ONLY can drive to Hairmasters at 502 S. McClun in Bloomington.

Satellite Site Information

Geometry in Construction-Normal West

1. Students will be remote learning to start the year. Instructors will be reaching out to share schedule, expectations, etc. Students may be invited in for labs--stay tuned for updates.

Laborers' Training--Stanford Training Facility

1. Students will follow the BACC/District 87 calendar.
- 2. Students will attend the course five days per week.**

Welding at Tri-Valley

1. Start date, September 8
2. Class Time: 8:15-9:40 a.m.
3. Parking--Go to Office first day for Parking Pass

4. Students will follow the Tri-Valley schedule (5-day weekly in-person; no classes on Wednesdays in September). Details can be found at www.tri-valley3.org.
5. Students will enter the building directly through the Metals Lab door (east side of building).

Welding at Heartland Community College

1. Students will follow the BACC/District 87 calendar.
2. **Students will attend in person four days per week, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday.**
3. Class Time: 12:15 p.m.-1:50 p.m.
4. Location: Heartland Community College, Workforce Development Center, Signs will direct you to the classroom. Enter East or West doors only.

Cosmetology

1. Students will follow the BACC/District 87 calendar.
2. Class times will be the same as all regular BACC classes.
3. Student temperatures will be taken daily at the entrance of the building, anyone without 100.4 won't be admitted.
4. Only disposable drinking bottles will be permitted (no refillable items).
5. FIRST Section students may drive directly to Hairmasters, 506 S. McClun, Bloomington, 61701. A shuttle will also be available from the Northeast corner of BACC/BHS.
6. SECOND and THIRD Section students will need to take the shuttle from BACC to Hairmasters on a daily basis. Students may NOT drive directly to Hairmasters.

Barbering
