WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Board of Education of School District #87, McLean County, Illinois, to ascertain, as near as practicable, how much money must be raised by special tax for transportation purposes, if any, and for educational and for operations and maintenance purposes for the next ensuing year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of School District #87, McLean County, Illinois, that there be and there is hereby levied,

the sum of \$27,300,000 as a special tax for educational purposes, and
the sum of \$4,375,000 as a special tax for operations and maintenance, and
the sum of \$438,000 as a special tax for leases and technology, and
the sum of \$1,750,000 as a special tax for transportation purposes, and
the sum of \$438,000 as a special tax for working cash, and
the sum of \$750,000 as a special tax for municipal retirement purposes, and
the sum of \$800,000 as a special tax for social security purposes, and
the sum of \$2,600,000 as a special tax for tort immunity purposes, and
the sum of \$350,000 as a special tax for special education purposes, and
the sum of \$350,000 as a special tax for life/safety purposes

on the equalized assessed value of all the taxable property in School District 87, McLean County, Illinois for the year 2020.



CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE TRUTH IN TAXATION LAW


I, the undersigned, do hereby certify that I am President of the Board of Education of Bloomington Public Schools, District #87, McLean County, Illinois, and
