BACC Facts & Figures

- ▶ Students served in 2021-2022 - 622
- ▶ 452 Industry Recognized Certifications were earned
- ▶ 77 students were inducted into the Technical Honor Society
- ▶ Resumes developed - 541
- ▶ 284 students earned dual credit
- ▶ Total Dual Credits Earned - 1,614 credit hours, with a value of \$337,875

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Additional BACC Facts

- **Cosmetology** students averaged 308 hours of instruction over the school year. These hours are applied to the total of 1,500 hours needed for a cosmetology license.
- **Barbering** students averaged 241 hours of instruction over the school year. These hours are applied to the total of 1,500 hours needed for a barbering license.
- The high number of hours earned by an individual in Cosmetology was 712 and 276 in Barbering.
- 116 Students with IEP's and 504's were served

BACC and SkillsUSA

BACC provides students the opportunity to compete in their area of study at the state and national level. This year, BACC had 72 students compete at the state level. At the State competition, BACC students earned 8 Gold Medals, 4 Silver Medals, and 11 Bronze Medals.

Nine BACC students competed at the National level in Atlanta, Georgia, in June. The week-long competition resulted in one BACC student, Katelyn Olson, being awarded the Gold Medal in Medical Terminology. SkillsUSA is an excellent co-curricular student organization that allows students to further grow beyond the classroom.

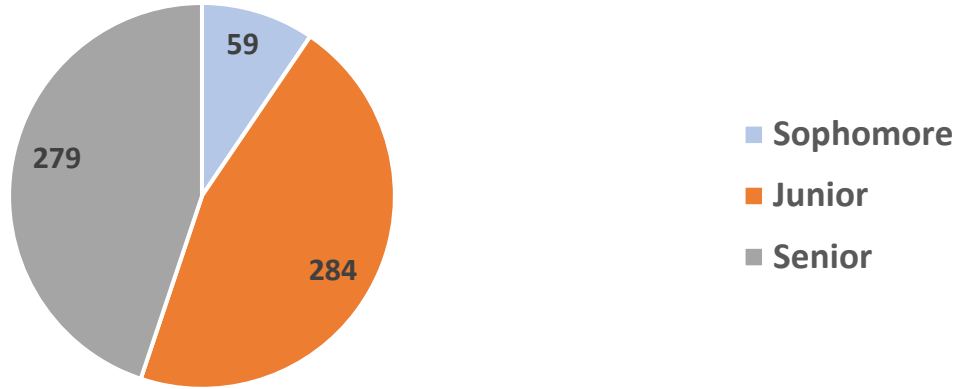

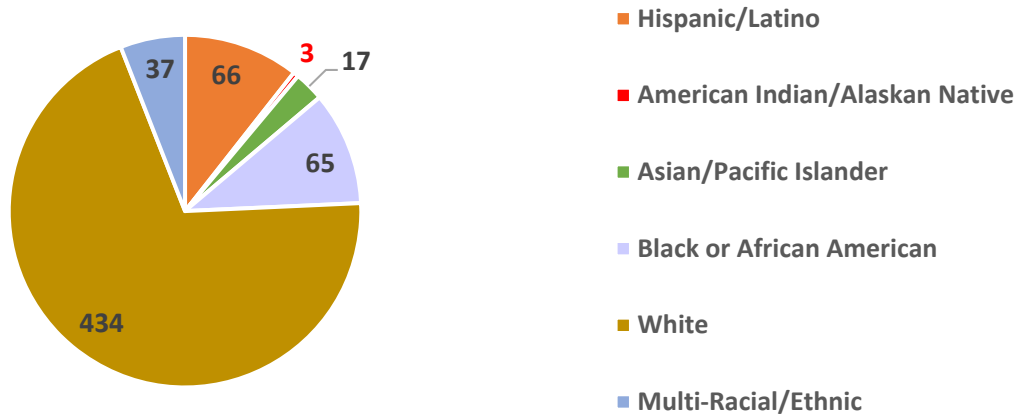

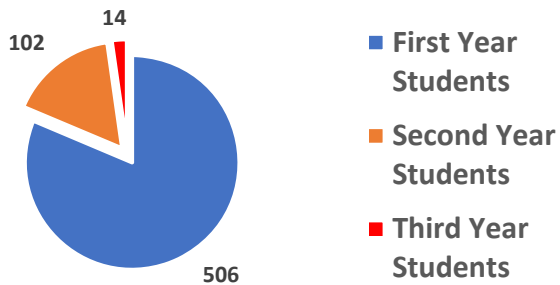
Year in School
