Did You Know?

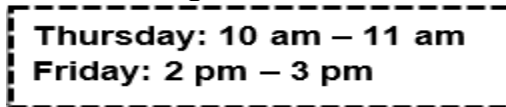
- Please keep in mind that your children cannot come into the school until 8:20 when breakfast starts. If your child does not eat breakfast at school, they can arrive at 8:45.

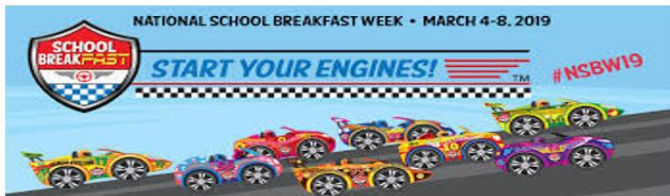
If you have box tops please send them to school with your student. Box tops are an easy way for the school to earn extra money!

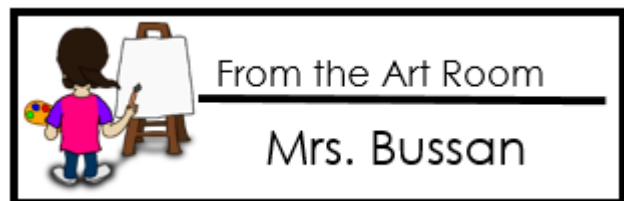

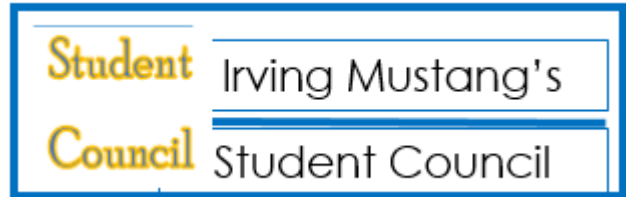
SHINE continues to have fun on Wednesday's after school! Female speakers from the community bring joy to our meetings. There will be no SHINE on March
