Arrival and Dismissal

Our students are welcome to come to school at 8:45-9:00 AM for breakfast. Please do not drop them off prior to breakfast time. Classes start at 9:00 AM and end at 3:15 PM. We will dismiss students at 3:15 PM starting with bus riders first, then pick-ups, followed by walkers, and then students going to day care. If you transport your student to school, please drop off and pick up students on LEE STREET by the black gate. Please stay in your car in order to make the car line move faster. Teachers will bring the students to your vehicle. Place your student's name and teacher name on the windshield to help our teachers identify your vehicle.

Everyone who enters the building must wear a mask. We will not be doing the self-certification tickets as we did last year. By sending your student to school, you are certifying the student does not have COVID symptoms. If your child suffers from allergies and has symptoms similar to COVID, please make sure your child's physician provides a letter that specifically identifies those symptoms and turn the note in to Nurse Sue.

We continue to put mitigation protocols in place at our school this year. If you will be visiting our building, please make an appointment ahead of time and wear a mask. Notes from the Nurse



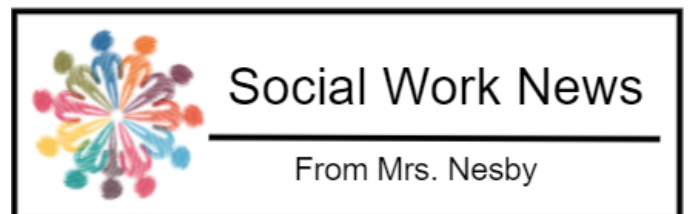

If your student has asthma, it is important to have an inhaler and an asthma action plan at school. Your child's doctor can order another inhaler for school and fill out the proper forms.
