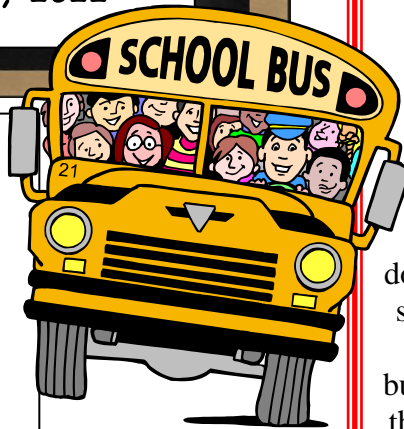
August 30th - Orientation Night-First Grade times are 6:00pm and 6:30pm.

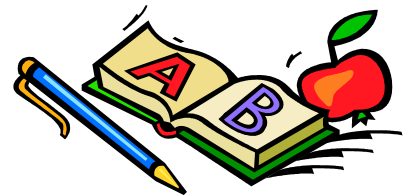
