



COVID Procedures for District 87 Schools

District 87 is following guidance from the Illinois State Board of Education, Illinois Department of Public Health, and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

By following these health requirements as a community, we can limit the transmission of COVID-19 in schools and continue providing a safe educational environment for students and staff.



Staying Safe

- Wear masks properly
- Stay 6 feet apart
- Complete symptom certification daily
- Deep clean schools daily
- Wash hands often
- Wash/replace masks daily
- Stay home when sick



Positive Cases

- Student/staff who test positive (and any household members) must quarantine at home. May return to school after 10 days pass, without fever for 24 hours, and if symptoms have improved.
- D87 will notify families of a positive case at school. Personal information will not be disclosed.



Close Contacts

- Contact tracing will be completed with help from the McLean County Health Department.
- Families will be notified if their student must quarantine due to close contact.
- The CDC describes close contact as being within 6 feet of a positive case for a total of 15 min. per day.
