



For Academic Year 2020-2021 Courses ~ Career Center Students ~

You must submit the Heartland student application to earn both high school **AND** college credit through this program.

- There is **no** application fee.
- Placement testing is **not** required.

You **do not** have to re-submit the Heartland student application if you:

- are a 2nd year career center student who has already submitted the Heartland application and earned dual credit
- submitted the Heartland application for dual credit courses at your high school

The online application process may take approximately 10 minutes to complete. You will need to enter your correct:

- date of birth
- social security number
- HS graduation month & year
- email address other than your HS account

- Heartland will send your acceptance letter to the email address entered on your application **3 to 5 days after** successful application submission. *Be sure to check your email spam/junk folder.*
- Heartland will enroll students based on the dual credit rosters submitted by each career center.
- Your primary contact people are your high school counselor and career center instructors or staff.
