1. Kindergarten is working on keeping a steady beat by patting on their laps. Please find songs you like to listen to at home and see if your child can pat, clap, and march to the steady beat in these songs.
2. We are working on dividing words into syllables to get ready for musical rhythms. Find items around the house and see if they can divide them into syllables and clap their names (book=1 syllable or clap.....refrigerator has 5!)
3. Have your child teach you the song "Bluebird, Bluebird" and teach your family the game that goes along with it! We have done this song and activity several times in class.
4. Practice singing folk songs that you know to your child! (This Old Man, Twinkle Twinkle Little Star, etc...)

Reading Activities

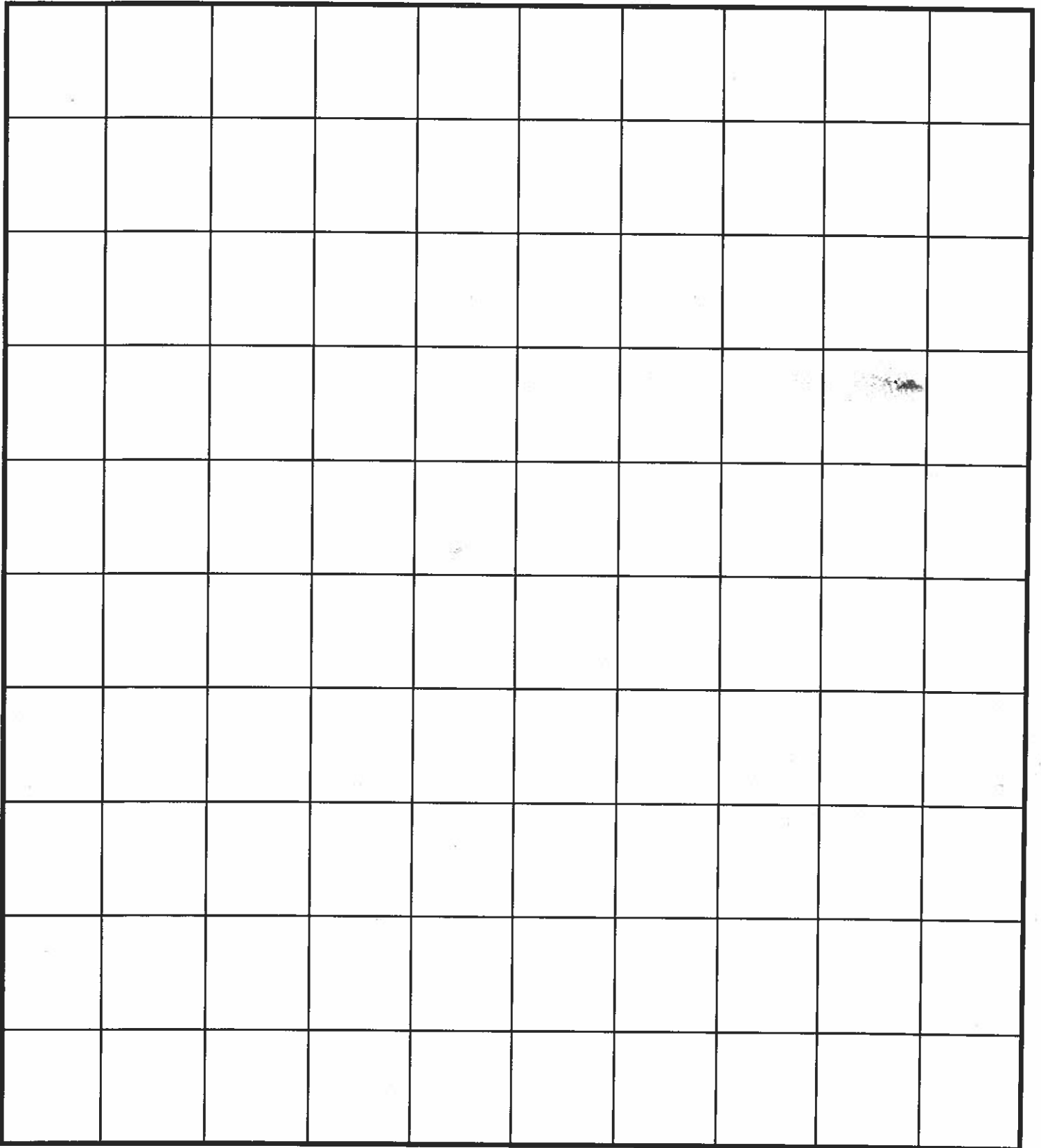
Please choose ONE of the following options to complete with your child:

- 2- Have your child produce rhyming words for the following:
mad, dog, big, hen, tug
 - Have your child “chop apart” the sounds in the following:
Hug, cot, fin, man, fun, top, big, nut, ran, dug (if you tell your child “chopper up” he/she will put their two hands together to chop the words apart. It should sound like this h-u-g- with a short pause between the sounds.
