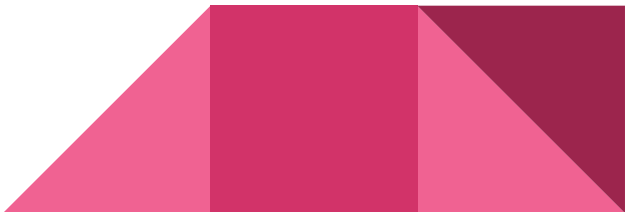
Curriculum and Orientation

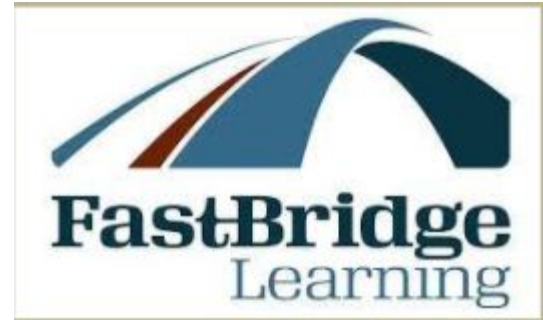
Social Studies and Science

District Assessment

FastBridge is a computer based, formative assessment that is administered three times a year. This data is then used for teachers to adjust and improve their instructions to meet student needs.

FastBridge offers assessments in Reading, Math, and Social Emotional Behaviors.



State Assessment

The Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) is the state assessment and accountability measure for Illinois students enrolled in a public school district. IAR assesses the New Illinois Learning Standards Incorporating the Common Core and will be administered in English language arts and mathematics to all students in grades 3-8.

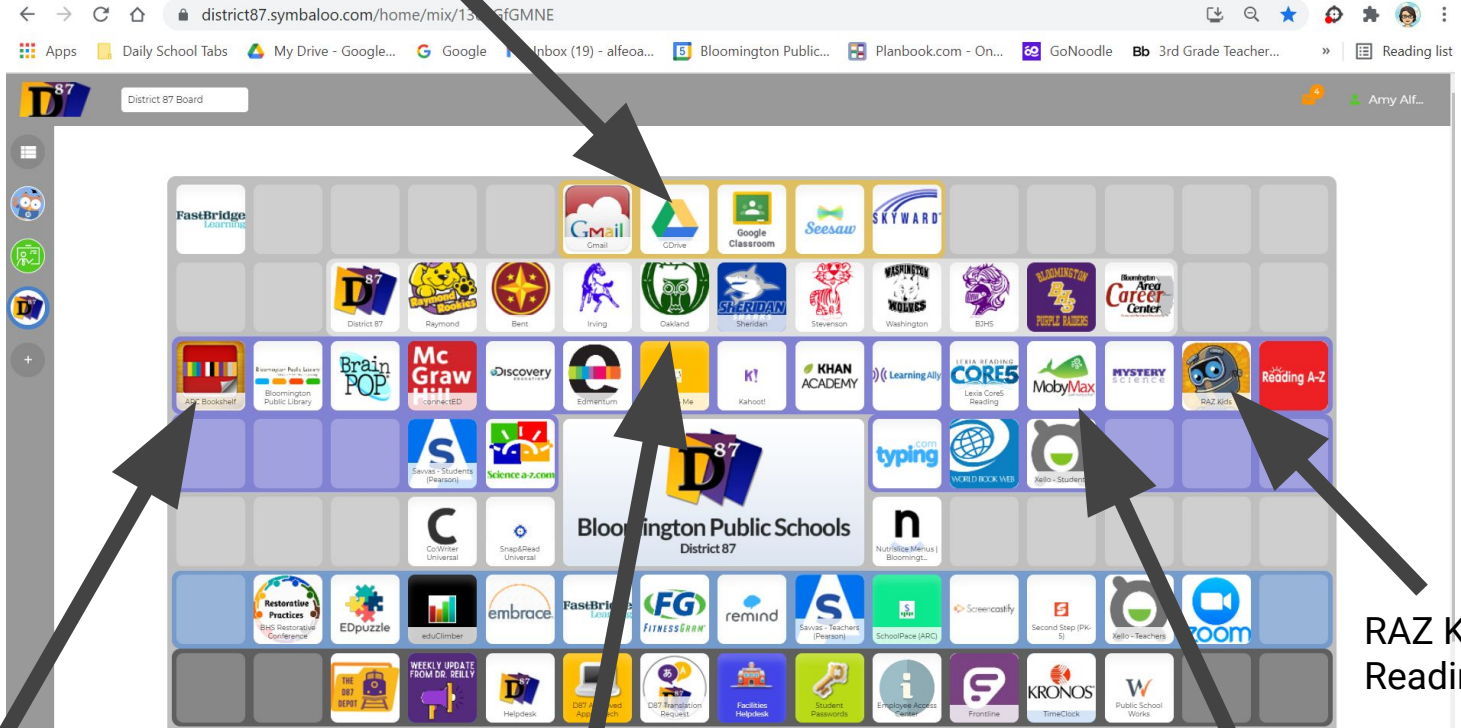
